## **Terms & Conditions**

- 1. Follow all the Rules and Regulations Laid down by the Organization, failing which the Students work can be discontinued.
- 2. Student's bags and covers are not allowed inside the lab.
- 3. Locate and when appropriate, learn to use exists, fire extinguishers, eyewash, first aid kit, broken glass container and clean-up materials for spills.
- 4. **DO NOT** eat, drink, or apply cosmetics in the laboratory. Confine long hair, loose clothing and dangling jewellery.
- 5. Clean and wipe down the Work Bench before and after experiments. When working with bacterial cultures, wipe the bench top with disinfectant before and after the laboratory exercise.
- 6. Report any injuries or accidents and all spills to instructor immediately. Do not work with any uncovered cuts. Cover them with a band aid.
- 7. **Assume** all chemicals and other reagents are hazardous and avoid any direct contact with them. **NEVER** pipette by mouth. Use mechanical devices.
- 8. Wash skin immediately and thoroughly if contaminated by chemicals or micro-organisms.
- 9. **NEVER** leave heat sources unattended. Keep containers of alcohols, acetone and other flammable liquids away from flames.
- 10. Do not allow any liquid to come in contact with electric cords. Handle electrical connectors with dry hands. Do not attempt to disconnect electrical equipment that crackles snaps or smokes.
- 11. Disposable items should be placed in BIO-HAZARD container. Reusable items should be placed in designated area.
- 12. Registration fee is to be paid compulsorily. The course fee should be paid in full before start of the work
- 13. Students should handle the instruments in the presence of the respective staff only. Put off all the instruments and computers after use.
- 14. In case of mishandling of instruments or breakages, the candidate has to bear the entire cost of repair / replacement.
- 15. Breakage of glassware will be charged to the student, which has to be paid immediately.
- 16. Books and journals will not be issued outside the lab, students will have to enter into register to refer the same inside the reference section.
- 17. External devices like pen-drives, CD etc will not be entertained in the computers and without the notice of the faculty.
- 18. Upon completion of course, completed report of the work done should be submitted in soft copy to the institute within a period of one month after completion of the project / training, Certificates will be issued after report submission.
- 19. No certificates will be issued until the report is submitted in full and the dues have been paid. Certificates have to be collected within a month of completion of project / training or a fine of 200/will be charged.
